

Print Care & Archival Longevity

A quiet set of practices for keeping your photograph present, stable, and cared for over time.

01 PLACE

Choose a stable indoor setting. Keep the artwork away from damp rooms, condensation, radiators, vents, and rapid swings in temperature or humidity.

02 LIGHT

Avoid direct, intense sunlight and concentrated heat. Soft, indirect room light helps preserve the photograph's tonal balance and the surrounding materials.

03 HANDLE

When the print must be moved, use clean cotton gloves, hold it by the edges, and support the full sheet or frame. Keep food, drinks, and liquids away from the artwork.

04 CLEAN

Do not spray cleaner near the photograph or frame. Dust the exterior gently with a soft, lint-free cloth and follow the framer's material-specific instructions for glazing.

05 KEEP THE RECORD

Retain your order record, edition details when supplied, and any Certificate of Authenticity with the work. Contact the studio before changing a frame or mounting system.

A NOTE FROM THE STUDIO

These are general care recommendations. When your order record or framing professional provides more specific material guidance, follow that guidance first.
